Your park is invited to take part in "Paint the Park" with international award-winning songwriter and accomplished painter Chad Elliott. As part of the project, Elliott will create a painting inspired by your park AND he will perform a live concert right in the park. And the best part? It's free.

About the Park Painting:

- Elliott will visit your park and create the painting on the same day as the live concert. The public is encouraged to watch Elliott's art process while he is painting.
- He will give you, as the managing organization of the park, rights to reproduce the artwork at no cost. You can use this image in advertising, fundraising or merch sales whatever your organization chooses as a gesture of thanks for hosting him.
- The original painting will be available for you to purchase, but this isn't a necessity. If you choose not to purchase it, Elliott will sell the original to a private party.
- Elliott plans to use select paintings from the Paint the Park series in a published book.

About the Live Concert:

- Elliott will provide a sound system for the event and excellent live music, but the organization of
 the concert will be up to you. Your organization can choose the location, time and other details,
 but he asks that the event be open to the public. Dates are subject to Elliott's schedule.
- Advertising and public draw to the show will be the responsibility of your organization. Chad will also help promote the event on social media and his web site.
- Tips via pass the hat or a donation jar will be collected at the live show and Elliott will accept this as his fee for the performance. If you prefer not to have donations collected, you may pay an upfront fee of \$750 for the show.

Consider this an opportunity to have a piece of your park preserved via art as well as an excellent live music event for your community!
